## **Enchanted Lantern Remuneration**

Each Enchanted Lantern contribution will help your local Grotto receive money for local charitable endeavors.

- ∞ The first 10 Enchanted Lanterns - the Grotto receives \$50
- ∞ The first 20 Enchanted Lanterns - the Grotto receives \$100
- ∞ For each increment of 5 Enchanted Lanterns contributed after 20, the Grotto receives an additional \$50

For example, 25 Enchanted Lanterns = \$150; 30 Enchanted Lanterns = \$200.

The money that the Grotto receives is to be used **ONLY** for local charitable endeavors. If the Grotto chooses, this money can also be returned to the Humanitarian Foundation. Those contributions will be processed and will count towards the next year's Enchanted Lantern total.
